News From The Royal Danish Embassy

Ambassador Joined the launch of Bersih Indonesia Project in Malang Regency

Ambassador <u>Lars Bo Larsen</u> joined the launch of Bersih Indonesia project in Malang Regency, East Java. The global NGO, <u>Alliance to End Plastic Waste</u>, will invest 29 Mio USD in Malang to provide an end-to-end solution to eliminating plastic waste. This includes operating 1.100 new garbage trucks, 5 material recovery facilities, 4 waste stations, and a total make-over of the waste system which will open >3.000 new jobs.

In Malang, Ambassador Lars Bo Larsen also visited <u>24Slides</u>. A Danish technology company with almost 200 staff in Malang serving global customers, including the largest Danish companies like Maersk, Novo Nordisk, Novozymes, and Carlsberg on how they present themselves.

Embassy Environment Counsellor Delivered an Opening Remark in Indonesia's Circular Economy Workshop & Capacity Building

Embassy Environment Counsellor <u>Julie B. Appelqvist</u> delivered an opening remark in Indonesia's Circular Economy Workshop and Capacity Building.

In the past few years, Denmark has fully supported the acceleration of the circular economy in Indonesia through cooperation with Ministry of National Development Planning of the Republic of Indonesia/Bappenas RI and UNDP.

This project concluded "The Economic, Social and Environmental Benefits of a Circular Economy in Indonesia" study. The next step is to assist Indonesia in developing "CE <u>action plans</u>". To accomplish this goal and enable multi-collaboration on CE, stakeholders' capacity needs to be increased.

This event invited 50+ stakeholders from various ministries, industries, and associations. During the intensive 3-day training, CE experts were disseminating the "Circular Economy Capacity Building Module Kit". Hopefully, this can be a good start of multistakeholder collaboration and strengthening bilateral cooperation in the environment.

Attendees had good opportunities to network both before and after the keynote presentations.


We thank all participants for their interest in our event, and we would like to express our gratitude to Maersk Indonesia for hosting the event.
